LyondellBasell's Morris Site is an integrated facility that was built in 1969 and is located 60 miles from Chicago. The site is one of the few petrochemical facilities in the Midwest. The Morris Site includes the following production units: ethylene, low density polyethylene, linear low polyethylene and high density polyethylene. It is the largest manufacturing firm in Grundy County and the 8th largest employer in the county. The plant includes an onsite cogeneration power plant and a waste water treatment facility. The Morris Site is a member of the American Chemistry Council of Illinois and the Three Rivers Manufacturers Association.
